

Olympic Logging Conference Scholarship Program

The Olympic Logging Conference (OLC) scholarship program is offered to sons and daughters of OLC attendees or OLC attendees wishing to pursue higher education after high school graduation. It is designed to help supplement costs of tuition, books, room and board while attending vocational school, community college or university. The scholarship award will be sent directly to the recipient's school and deposited into the student's account. If a recipient receives but does not apply the total amount of the money for education, that amount not applied shall be reported to the OLC and returned.

Criteria

- The sons and daughters of OLC attendees or OLC attendees wishing to pursue higher education after high school graduation may apply.
- Proof of acceptance to vocational school, community college or university is required.
- A \$500.00 (minimum) shall be awarded.
- Annual application is required.
- The scholarship application must be completed in full.
- All applications must be returned to the Olympic Logging Conference, PO Box 2808, Port Angeles, WA 98562 and postmarked by **May 31** to be considered for award distribution within the upcoming school year.
